Annual Report of Year-2020 (Phase-IV)

Duration: January-December, 2020 Education Project, Ramu, Cox's Bazar.

Introduction:

The first, second and third phase (5 year each) of the Dakbhanga Education Project ended in November 2019. This report covers the 1st year of the fourth phase, but mostly 2020.

Annual activities:

The annual sports and cultural program happened according to the planning. The picnic was organized properly. During the reporting period we enjoyed the picnic. Both school students enjoyed the picnic at Dakbhanga Primary School. Due to government restriction this year we didn't go to outside of school for Picnic for COVID-19 Pandemic. SMC members and project staff were present during both picnics. The staff picnic were properly organized in March-2020 at Ali Kadam, Bandarban. The annual sports of this year were held in due time at Dakbhanga Primary school. Students of both school participated in the annual sports. The cultural programme and prize giving ceremony was held in Moishkum Osman Sarwar Primary School. During the prize giving ceremony was as chief guest. Mr. Md. Mostak Ahmed, Chairman of Kawerkhop Union Parisad, Mr. Md. Ali Haider, Head Teacher, Kawerkhop Hakim Rakima High School including all staff of his school staff, Mrs. Nasrin Sultana, Head Teacher, Naikongchory Girls High School, Md. Jewel Talukder, Project Coordinator of Dakbhanga Bangladesh, Md. Rokonuzzaman Khan, Administrative Officer of Dakbhanga Bangladesh, SMC president of both school, community peoples, guardians, journalist, non residential students and project staff were also present the program. Students of both schools performed in the program. Guests were very pleased to observe the performance of students. We observed International mother language day and Independent day in the school level. PC and AO participated different national and international day in the upazila level. We organized meeting with SMC and guardians during the students examination result publish. SMC and guardians gives us different suggestion and opinion to run the project smoothly. CR and ACR visited the project regularly. They mostly attended the monthly management meetings & teacher`s meeting. Management takes necessary decisions properly to run the project smoothly. CR and ACR visited schools' activities during the reporting period. The SMC of Dakbhanga and Moishkum School used to visit the school regularly. Both SMC presidents of both school are very caring for the best interest of children.

Events in both schools:

A little doctor training was held in February-2020 at Naikongchori Upazilla health complex. Total 20 students, 4 teachers, PC & AO received the training. The trainer was a govt. doctor of little doctor training from Naikonchori Upazilla Health complex. Our little doctors group used to go to community for discussing concerned messages on health issues and different diseases with mothers and children. 04 teachers lead the little doctors group. Community people, guardians and SMC appreciate for these types of activities.

Government regular PECE examination was not held for COVID-19. We arranged an special examination in a short form with 25 % marks in each subject for proper evidence based documentation.

There are no staff vacancies during the reporting period.

Two of our ex-students of Dakbhanga named Arefa Akter Rifa and Saleha Akter successfully working as teacher to facilitate quality classroom activities. Arefa Akter Rifa and Saleha Akter are working at Dakbhanga Primary School. The SMC and local community appreciated their recruitment and they are proud of it.

Main targets of the project for Year 1 of phase 4 with Progress till the end of December- 2020.

1. To run and maintained the existing two primary schools in two villages of Ramu Upazila of Cox's Bazar District:
 - a) To run the existing two Primary Schools.
 - b) Two schools will have all necessary furniture, equipment and education materials:
 - As requirement of two schools, all necessary furniture, equipment and educational materials provided. These are mainly some text books (which are not given from govt. with free of cost), the exercise books, pens, khata and other educational stationeries.

2. To improve the educational level by providing primary education:

Children of 5-12 years enrolled for primary education;

a) All the children of age group of primary education of the two villages will be enrolled for primary education:

- The family survey of this year organized in January -2020 within the project area. During the Survey 1,000 children of age 5 – 12 years were identified and out of them 882 children were enrolled in the schools/madras in (religious schools) this year. Among them 447 students enlisted in the project schools. The enrolment rate is 88.2 % of the total and 50.68% the enlisted in the project schools of the enlisted children.

b) About 447 students of two schools will receive quality primary education.

- 447 students of the area are receiving the quality primary education in two project's Schools.

- To provide uniforms for all the students.

All children of Pre-school and Class -1 to Class –V of the project have received uniforms of same color with only making charge for tailoring. The project discussed with guardians and SMC before fixed up the tailoring charge. This year not distributed dress for COVID-19.

- To co-operate with the Education Officials and Local Govt. of the project working area.

Education officer and assistant education officer visited the school at several times and them thanks to all for great job. They were very much satisfied on our performed activities. Our Project teachers participated in the Children Survey in the project area. We participated the monthly NGO coordination meeting at Upazilla level. UNO, UEO and others Govt. officials were present in the meeting.

3. To continue improvement of the secondary/higher educational level of the children of the area by providing support for the secondary/higher education to a limited number of the poor and meritorious students who passed from the primary school:

- a) To support the poor and meritorious students to get admission in the best local secondary/higher level.
- b) To provide necessary educational materials, admission, examination and registration fee to the students.

There is no residential student in project. In 2020 the project supported 25 students for secondary education as non residential students. 20 students new who passed class V in 2019

and another 5 from previous best. Students are studying in Khowerkhop Hakim Rakima High school (18), Naikongchori Govt. High school (1), Naikongchori girls High school (5), Ramu Khijari Govt. High School (1). Office provided their admission, examination, and registration fee and education materials.

The result of the secondary students who have passed from the project schools is satisfactory. All the students are very attentive and interested for their class. Project staff always communicates with teachers regarding on students education.

4. To ensure quality primary education by continue to provide necessary training to the teachers:

The end of December-2020 total number of teachers in two Schools is 14 (2 part time teachers). Now 02 of our ex. students are working as teacher at Dakbhanga Primary School. All are skilled and motivated to work with children. They are always hard working for ensure quality education. I think it is very good for Dakbhanga Bangladesh.

5. To provide quality education for the children in the locality:

To ensure quality education to the children of Schools several steps were taken during this reporting period. Among those the main steps are described below:

- Academic Calendar 2020:

The Academic Calendar of -2020 was developed and implemented from the beginning of the year. The calendar was developed with the recommended on project staff. It is hoped that this would guide the Teachers to provide the quality education of the Schools. This year teachers were very good enjoying summer vacation.

- Monthly class test:

A regular monthly class test of students was not continuing during this reporting period for COVID-19.

- Development of the Teachers:

To improve the basic knowledge of the Teachers, monthly written tests were taken.

The mentioned test has taken before the starting of each staff monthly Meeting. It has found that all the teachers were trying to go through the Text Books and to gain general knowledge from the concerned sources to achieve better result in the monthly test. Till the end of the reporting period this test was found helpful for the improvement of the teachers. From the year 2012 , we used to organize special increment for the best employee of the year. In the last year Umme Salma & Marjia Begum jointly got award for the best employees of the year 2020. We also provide a award as best initiator in a year to appreciate the teachers special efforts for the organization. In 2020 Mr. Md. Abul Kalam, Head Teacher of Moishkum Osman Sarwar Primary School got the best initiator award for his leadership and community linkage.

- Picnics Sports and Cultural program:

The sports and picnic are very much helpful for bringing the children to the schools. These also bring the attention of the guardians to send their children to school. The Sports and Picnic of the Year 1 all ready have been done in timely. Due to government restriction, we organized both picnic at Dakbhanga Primary School. The Picnic and sports were fruitful, interesting and enjoyable. The students, guardians, community people enjoyed the picnic and cultural program. The cultural program was presented by the students. That was appreciated by SMC and guardians. This year we completed our sports at Dakbhanga Primary School. The cultural program and prize giving ceremony was held at Moishkum Osman Sarwar Primary School field. Local chairman, journalist, SMC members and local elite persons were present in the program. They enjoyed the program PC, AO & all teachers were also present.

- Providing education materials, uniforms and logistic support to the students:

To support the parents the project provided the education materials and logistics to the children. It helped the children to be more attentive in the study other than pressuring the parents who in fact, are not able to provide these. It helps in reducing the dropout rate. During this period the project provided sufficient education materials to the students. The education materials included text books, khata, exercise books, ball pens, colour pencils, uniforms etc and for secondary residential students all ready provided geometry box, pen, calculator etc. The students could get as much as they can use for their study. For these education materials they did not have to pay any money. The project procures these materials and supply free of cost to the students of the Schools. The uniform was distributed among the students with minimum making charge of parents.

6. To continue making aware and motivate the parents/guardians to send their Children for compulsory primary education and secondary education through School Management Committees.
 - a) To continue the support two School Management Committees and train them for capacity building.

Two Schools Management Committees of the Schools were established and functioning well. Regular meeting was held according to the plan. The problems of the Schools were discussed in the meetings and decisions were taken. SMC suggest the project to take any decision and help project staff to run the project smoothly. During the reporting period 10 meetings were held in two Schools. Average attendance was 82%.

- b) To continue the support School Management Committees to motivate the parents so that they willingly send their children to school.

The guardians of two schools are participating in the regular meeting to share the results of their children. These meetings helped motivate the parents to send their children to school regularly and reduce the dropout rate. Guardians expressed their opinion in the meeting.

7. To reduce child labor in the area by sending the children to the schools:

Reduction of dropout in primary education:

Child labor is one of the main problems of the area. To reduce the child labor is also a great challenge of the project. It related with many factors. So to address this problem is not an easy task. However, the project took this challenge to reduce the child labor to a great extent. To achieve this target the project has undertaken a number of initiatives. Among these sponsorship students, Family Survey, Guardians meetings, Feder School/ Adult Education , different community engagement etc is the main initiatives of the project.

A family survey of the children of age 5 to 14 years in the villages under two School were undertaken. It was found that a total of 1,000 children of that age group were identified in the area. Among them 882 children were enlisted to the primary schools and madrasas (religious schools) this year. It is more than 88 %. It is to be noted that the target group of this year was 5-14 years of children where it was 5-12 in the past years. It was done as per government requirement. So if the data of the last year is compared with the data of this year then there might be a confusion about the enlistment coverage. The Government Official appreciated the situation of the enrolment of the project area. The higher coverage were done through the hard work of the whole team and the school committee of both school to motivate the parents. - **Reduction of dropout in secondary education:**

Total 636 students passed from the project supported Schools in last 16 years. 17 students of them did not go for secondary education for less interest of their guardians and other problems. From the remaining 636, total dropouts in sixteen years are 2.95 % students of them are still studying in the secondary schools. So it is found that the project influenced a lot of reducing the dropout rate and ultimately the reduction in child labor in the area. Last year total 61 students passed from both school. 25 students continuing their study from the support of project. Rest 36 students continuing their study without any support from project. The student status from starting to end of December-2020 is shown below:

- **Motivating the parents to send their children to schools:**

Guardians meeting were organized during publication of the results of monthly tests and final exams. The results of individuals are shared with their parents. The best students of the classes are appreciated with small prizes. It improved the attendance of the guardian meetings. After sharing the results an action plan is prepared for the next step. The School Management Committee (SMC) members also attended the monthly guardians' meetings. They discussed the different issues of the schools and make their decisions. This process is helping them to share ideas, come to a consensus and respect the others opinions. They also visited the schools time to time.

B. Management, Supervision and Monitoring:

The management committee of the organization has been formed with the Country Representative, Project Coordinator, Administrative Officer, Head Teachers of Dakbhanga and Moishkum Primary School and two women teachers' representatives of two schools. This committee worked very hard till the whole year to continue uninterrupted service to the students. The main tasks they have done as to preparation the annual reports for the NGO Affairs Bureau and the Headquarter of Darbhanga, selection of new students for sponsorship, liaise with the GOB etc. Management also selected best employee of the year.

Financial management:

Last 2012 the staff salary was increased. The starting salary of a teacher has been increased from 4,600 BDT to 7,109 BDT. The starting salary of a Head teacher is fixed as 10,325 Taka, Other staff salary raised about 18%. Teachers of Dakbhanga school getting extra 2% as remote allowance. In January-2020 salary of all staff of Dakbhanga Bangladesh was not increase for budget limitation.

The permission of the fund release for year 1 of Phase IV has been received from the Government of Bangladesh. After the permission the fund for year 1 has been received from the Donor Dakbhanga – Belgium.

C. Necessary Activities at the Lockdown in pandemic situation.

2020 was a horrible year of the world due to COVID-19. While COVID-19 situation were gone out of hand GOB declared lockdown. After 16th march 2020, Director General (DG) of the Directorate of Primary Education (DPE) published 23rd November in their website www.dpe.gov.bd (Memorandum no 38.01.0000.145.99.046.2020-1245, **Learner's Grading from Class one to class five**), that every Government, Non-government school should take self-initiative to evaluate Learners standard or Grade. Students Learn from Sangsad Bangladesh Television, Bangladesh betar, Community Radio and Mobile phone or any other digital way by the support of their teacher.

Dakbhanga Bangladesh Management decided to take self-initiative to maintain Quality Education and Others humanitarian assistance in their catchment areas.

Both Schools teacher form some group in every class and ensured their learning with the help of mobile phone, Sangsad Television, Bangladesh betar & Radio etc. Some time they did Home Visit activities maintain Health & hygiene rules.
